Mt. SAC Planning Document Ready for Review

The first complete draft of *Mt. San Antonio College's 2018 Educational and Facilities Master Plan* (EFMP) is available for review. Mt. SAC is seeking comments on the plan, which serves as the foundation for other components of the college's integrated planning process and cycle of continuous quality improvement. The document has been in the making for 18 months. Reviewers are asked to look for factual errors and/or areas in which something should be added.

The specific purposes of the EFMP are described as follows:

- Develop and analyze internal and external data to identify the major challenges that currently exist or are anticipated to exist in the next 10 years;
- Project the College's overall growth and the growth of programs and services over the next 10 years;
- Provide a common foundation for discussion about the College's programs and facilities;
- Develop recommendations for site and facilities improvements that are informed by educational planning;
- Provide a foundation for other College plans, such as the Strategic Plan and the Technology Plan; and
- Inform the public of the College's intentions and garner support for the services provided in and to the community.

Comments about grammar, pagination, or format issues should not be included as the final document will be carefully reviewed for these details.
