The revenue appropriations consist of the operating budget (\$19,827,505), transfers in (\$778,745), and other financing source (\$2,886,550). The expenditure appropriations consist of the operating budget (\$18,664,015), transfers out (\$778,745), and the capital projects (\$3,603,000).
