RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Parks and Recreation Commission receive and file the Parks and Maintenance Report for July.

BACKGROUND:

This report is prepared and provided for the Parks and Recreation Commission for review and information on the current status of the maintenance and operations of the City of Walnut's Park system.

The Maintenance Division of the Community Services Department manages general park maintenance at all City parks. General maintenance is performed largely by a landscape maintenance contractor and some by the City staff. The general maintenance includes mowing, edging, hedging, pruning of shrubs and trees, as well as the monitoring of rodents and pests. It also includes irrigation audits and playground inspections. Restroom maintenance services are provided by the custodial contractor. Park restrooms are open and maintained seven days a week, with the exception of two holidays per year (Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day).

City parks with sports fields are maintained at an optimum level through the services of sports field specialists. City staff augments the maintenance services through regular inspections and audits of the fields.

City maintenance staff also performs special projects in all parks including graffiti removal and playground equipment repairs. In order to conform to California playground standards, staff performs playground inspections on a weekly basis.

AQUATICS:

The Recreation Division Sharks Swim Team began continued through July, practices are held Monday through Friday from 7:00 am to 9:00 am. The Sharks Swim team competed in two swim meets. On July 20 they competed against various cities throughout San Gabriel Valley and on July 27 they competed against the City of Azusa. Sharks coaches and swimmers are preparing for their final meet of the summer at the SCMAF Championships where they will swim against cities throughout Southern California

Group and private swim classes continued throughout July, with classes starting at 9:30 am and running approximately 30 minutes throughout the day. The Aquatics program will run for 10 weeks and will also have lap swim for adults and a youth lifeguard camp and junior lifeguard camp available. The Junior Lifeguard Camp was held July 8 through August 2 and had 10 participants ranging in ages 13 to 17 years old learned skills to be future lifeguards as well receive their First Aid & CPR certification

SPORTS LEAGUES & CLASSES:

Spring/Summer Adult Basketball league continued in the month of July with a total of 29 teams playing on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Teams will compete in 10 league games and playoffs for both nights began in July. Championship games will be played in August. All vendors paid a facility use fee of \$120 each for a spot at our event.

Music and Movies in the Park
