8. Public Hearings for Land Use Entitlements

C/Wu asked if the recommendation stated that land use public hearings would not take place via teleconference, to which CA/Leibold confirmed as such.

10. Award of Bid to Eide Bailly, LLP for Auditing Services

Recommendation: That the City Council award the bid for Auditing Services to Eide Bailly, LLP for three (3) fiscal years ending June 30, 2020, June 30, 2021, and June 30, 2022 and authorize the Mayor to sign the attached contract.

C/Wu inquired if there were any cost increases for audit services, to which FO/Cortez stated that there were none and they would not be increased for two fiscal years.

11. Award of Bid – 2019-2020 Maintenance Area 7 Slurry Seal Project

Recommendation: That the City Council:

- 1. Award a construction contract for the 2019-2020 Maintenance Area 7 Slurry Seal Project to Doug Martin Contracting Company, Inc. in the amount of \$827,499.75;
- 2. Reject all other bids;
- 3. Authorize staff to issue a Purchase Order to Doug Martin Contracting Company, Inc. in the amount of \$827,499.75;
- 4. Authorize staff to issue change orders not to exceed 10% of the contract award amount (\$82,749.97) to Doug Martin Contracting Company, Inc.; and
- 5. Approve a Purchase Order to RKA Consulting Group in the amount of \$75,000.

C/Wu asked which areas of the city the project would take place, to which CE/Gilbertson stated that the project would encompass neighborhoods east of Grand Avenue.

12. Award of Bid – FY 2019-2020 City-Wide Sidewalk and Concrete Repair Project

Recommendation: That the City Council:

- 1. Award a construction contract for the FY 2019-2020 City-Wide Sidewalk and Concrete Repair Project to CT&T Concrete Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$139,542.00;
- 2. Reject all other bids;
- 3. Appropriate \$29,606.20 from Available Prop C-13 Funds;
- 4. Authorize staff to issue a Purchase Order to CT&T Concrete Paving, Inc. in the amount of \$139,542.00;
- 5. Authorize staff to issue change orders not to exceed 10% of the contract award amount (\$13,954.20) to CT&T Concrete Paving; and
- 6. Approve a Purchase Order to RKA Consulting Group in the amount of \$20,000.

C/Wu asked which areas the project would take place, to which CE/Gilbertson clarified that repairs would take place as needed throughout the city.

ACM/Rooney stated that concrete work would also be done at Suzanne Park.
