

City of Walnut Automated License Plate Reader Program

The City of Walnut will continue operations of the Automated License Plate Reader program to deter criminal activity in the community.







What?

In response to concerns voiced by residents, the City will continue using the Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) program. Note: The cameras will be positioned to take photographs of vehicle license plates only. The data will only be released to the LA County Sheriff's Department or other law enforcement agency pursuant to a criminal investigation.

Where?

Cameras are installed at strategic locations throughout the City's boundaries.

How?

The ALPR camera system will be installed and maintained by an independent contractor using proprietary technology. All data is securely stored in a cloud-based server where all data is fully encrypted and automatically deleted every sixty (60) days. The ALPR system shall only be accessed or used by the City of Walnut Administrative Service Director or sworn LA County Sheriff Department officers.
