Debbie Lee, Stacy Manfredi, Suzanne Seeget, Mark Matten, Emily Worly, and Aaron Pedersen expressed concerns regarding the project including: proposed plans of the project and the stability of the hills in the areas surrounding the property.

Discussion took place amongst Council and staff regarding the appeal, the history of the property including the history of landslides in the surrounding areas, the current state of the surrounding hills, and subdivision requirements.

C/Tragarz expressed support for the Planning Commission's recommendation of denial of the project.
