M/Ching opened public comment.

Small business owners thanked council for their support.

William Harrison stated that he would like to see more diverse businesses in the city.

Carole Willis provided information on special needs recreational programs and asked council to solicit input from someone in the special needs community to help with special needs programing.

Vijay Vakil expressed support for helping small businesses that qualify for assistance and support for more cameras in the city.
