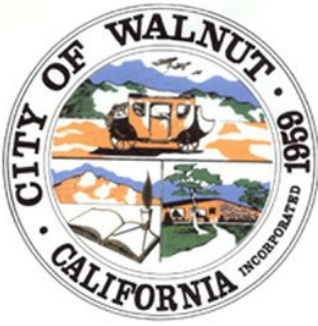

SUBJECT: SENIOR CENTER ACTIVITIES FOR JUNE 2022

SUMMARY:

The Senior Center staff has prepared a report summarizing the activities at the Walnut Senior Center during the past month.

COVID-19 Protocols Update:

The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health modified their Health Order to highly recommend indoor masking, regardless of vaccination status. Staff and program participants at the Senior Center and other City facilities have been updated of this modification.

ACTIVITIES SUMMARY:

The following are ongoing social services for older adults in Walnut that occurred last month. Staff continues to provide older adults in the community with pressing social services opportunities.

SENIOR CURBSIDE/HOME DELIVERED NUTRITION LUNCH PROGRAM

Staff continues to coordinate the County Nutrition Program for older adults, which had been a congregate meal program at the Walnut Senior Center. The program continues to operate as a hybrid pick-up/home delivery programs. Those residents who cannot leave their home continue to receive home delivered meals, while others are scheduled for drive-through (no contact) pick up. Los Angeles County has extended the curbside service to continue until further notice.

SENIOR DINE-IN NUTRITION LUNCH PROGRAM

As of June 20, Los Angeles County has reinstated the Senior Dine-In Nutrition Lunch program. The Dine-In program is open to older adults age 60 years and older. Currently we are serving hot meals Monday through Wednesday on a first-come first-serve basis. To participant, guest must complete an intake form, check-in opens at 10 :30 am with meals served from 11 :00 am to 12 :00 pm or until food is available.

SPECIAL EVENTS:

Luau Dinner and Dance

On Friday, June 24, the Senior Center held a Hawaiian Luau Dinner & Dance. The event featured the band, Global Affair, an authentic Hawaiian show by Da Hula Studio and prizes. A Hawaiian themed meal was catered by Da Kine Hawaiian Grindz Catering. The attendance for this dance was sold out at 120 guests. Participants enjoyed the evening festivities and all were given a special mahalo for attending. Oakmont Senior Living was our event partner with a contribution of \$500.

OLDER ADULT CLASSES:

Heart and Soul Line Dance classes have been in full swing offering lessons twice a week. Monday classes are perfect for the working older adult and scheduled for 6pm. Thursday classes are perfect for the retired person, scheduled for the morning at 9:30 am. These classes are a perfect way to good heart health without the constant strain on joints and easy to follow. All levels are welcome and no partners necessary.

Registration for the summer session of classes began on May 1 and continued through the month of May with online registration. Participants unable to register online or needing assistance are able to contact Mt. SAC directly or visit on any schedule date to speak with someone in person. Classes began the week of June 20.

GROW GROUP COUNSELING

The Senior Group GROW Group Counseling program has continued to be in person, since the transition of the virtual forum. GROW meets the first Friday of every month from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. Participants ages 55 and older are welcome and encouraged to learn new skills that will allow them to GROW.

SENIOR EXCURSIONS:

Registration for the summer trips began on May 9 for Walnut residents. All trips for the summer are currently full capacity. Capacity for trips have returned to full status. Here are the June excursions:
