1. Reddy Mixed-Use Project on Valley:

Development Agreement – A request for approval of a DA pursuant to Walnut Municipal Code (WMC) Chapter 6.112 (Development Agreement) and California Government Code Sections 65864 et seq. in connection with the development of a mixed-use project off Valley Boulevard consisting of commercial space(s), residential unit(s), and other related on-site improvements (APN(s): 8722-015-015 and – 016).

Tentative Tract Map (TTM) 82967 – A subdivision of approximately 0.34 acres of land/air-space into commercial and residential unit(s) and other related on-site improvements at an existing vacant site off Valley Boulevard, within the West Valley Specific Plan (WVSP) area (APN(s): 8722-015–015 and –016).

Site Plan and Architectural Review (SPC/AR) 2022-025 - A proposal to construct a Mixed–Use project consisting of residential unit(s), commercial space(s) and other related on-site improvements at an existing, vacant site off Valley Boulevard (APN(s): 8722-015–015 and –016).

Recommendation: That the City Council:

- 1. Open the Public Hearing;
- 2. Hear the Staff Report;
- 3. Receive testimony from the Applicant and any other members of the Public regarding the Project;
- 4. Discuss amongst Council Members;
- 5. Close Public Hearing; and
- 6. Approve the following:
 - a. Ordinance No. 22-09 Approving the DA in substantial form (Exhibit A)
 - b. Resolution No. 22-54 Approving TTM 82967 and SPC/AR 2022–025, subject to the attached Conditions of Approval (COA) in Exhibit B.

Recommendation: That the City Council adopt Resolution No. 22-55.

3. Resolution No. 22-56 – Salary Schedules

Recommendation: It is recommended that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 22-56, amending the City of Walnut Salary Schedules (Attachment 2) to comply with State of California minimum wage requirements.

4. Ordinance No. 22-07 - A Request to Rescind Sections 3.48.190 and 3.48.200 of Chapter 3.48 (Offenses) of the Walnut Municipal Code (WMC)

Recommendation: It is recommended that the City Council waive further reading and adopt by title only Ordinance No. 22-07 "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Walnut, County of Los Angeles, California, rescinding sections 3.48.190 and 3.48.200 of Chapter 3.48 (Offenses) of the Walnut Municipal Code."

5. Ordinance No. 22-08 – Approving the First Amendment to the Development Agreement (DA) for "The Terraces at Walnut" Project

Recommendation: It is recommended that the City Council Adopt, by title only, and waive further reading of Ordinance No. 22 – 08, "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Walnut, County of Los Angeles, State of California approving the First Amendment to the Development Agreement for the Terraces at Walnut project located north of Valley boulevard (APN: 8709-023-006/007/008)"

6. Approval of Citywide Internal Computer Replacement Project

Recommendation: That the City Council:

- 1. Approve the purchase of eighty (80) fully programmed computers (i.e. towers) and ten (10) monitors from GovConnection, Inc. in the amount of \$100,000;
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to issue a Purchase Order to GovConnection, Inc. for \$100,000;
- 3. Authorize the City Manager to execute a Purchase Order in the amount of \$19,000 for Microsoft 365 Business Standard;
- 4. Authorize the City Manager to execute a Purchase Order in the amount of \$11,000 for DUO Multi-Factor Authentication licenses; and
- 5. Appropriate \$143,000 from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds (08) to Computer Services (08-4502-8402) for miscellaneous equipment related items needed and associated labor cost(s) with the purchase and set-up of the City's replacement computers.

7. Appointment to San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control Board of Trustees

Recommendation: It is recommended that the City Council appoint Dr. Allen Wu to the San Gabriel Valley Mosquito and Vector Control District Board of Trustees for a two-year term through calendar years 2023 and 2024.

8. <u>Approval of Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Advertise and</u>
Receive Formal Bids for the FY 2022-23 Green Street Project

Recommendation: It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications and authorize the City Engineer to advertise to receive formal bids for the FY 2022-23 Green Street Project.

Recommendation: That the City Council make the following findings:

- 1. The City Council has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency related to COVID-19; and

- 4. Existing circumstances support the need to continue the local emergency (COVID-19) consistent with Resolution No. 20-25 Proclaiming Existence of a Local Emergency (COVID-19) adopted March 23, 2020 as amended by Resolution No. 20-32 adopted May 13, 2020.
