UPTICK IN CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

As of last quarter, the City has issued approximately 1,200 building permits, which is a 21.5% increase in the number of building permits issued around the same time, last year. The City anticipates that building permit numbers will continue to rise as newly approved residential and commercial

projects are finalized.
Building permits include residential additions,
Accessory Dwelling Units (ADUs), Solar System projects, commercial tenant improvements, and new construction. Building activity continues to be robust and Walnut will continue to implement new and innovative efforts to process permits as efficiently as possible.



2023 PUBLIC SAFETY MEETING

A joint public meeting with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and the Los Angeles County Fire Department will be held to review statistics from each organization in an open forum, and recognize their efforts in diligently serving the Walnut Community. The meeting will be held on Thursday, March 2nd, 2023 from 7:30 am to 9:00 am at the Senior Center. Members of the public are welcome, and encouraged to attend. Reminders will be generated as the event gets closer.



ENHANCED SHERIFF PATROLS CONTINUE

Over the past several weeks, City and Sheriff Staff have conducted evening meetings with residents from several neighborhoods (Belgate, Snow Creek, Creekside, etc.) to receive their input on public safety issues. Staff, in conjunction with our LA County Sheriff partners, have worked to enhance patrols throughout the City by adding an additional Deputy for targeted burglary suppression citywide. We have received feedback that this has increased Sheriff visibility throughout the City, especially in targeted areas. Also, an additional traffic patrol unit has been deployed twice a week for citywide traffic enforcement, as requested by many of our residents.

WALNUT VALLEY WATER DISTRICT-SUCCULENT WORKSHOP



SINGLE AUDIT

During this last week of January, the City Finance Department will be working with auditors as they conduct a Single Audit. Single Audits are required when state, county, local and other non-Federal entities expend \$750,000 or more in Federal financial assistance (i.e. ARPA funds). Walnut has been successful in exceeding the \$750,000 in Federal financial assistance, which has directly benefited the community. Staff anticipates the Single Audit report to be finalized by the end of February.
