## **COVID-19 PROTOCOL UPDATE:**

The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health continued their Health Order to highly recommend indoor masking, regardless of vaccination status. Staff and program participants at the Senior Center and other City facilities have been updated of this modification.

# **ACTIVITIES SUMMARY:**

The following are ongoing social services for older adults in Walnut that occurred last month. Staff continues to provide older adults in the community with pressing social services opportunities.

#### SENIOR CURBSIDE/HOME DELIVERED NUTRITION LUNCH PROGRAM

Staff continues to coordinate the County Nutrition Program for older adults, which had been a congregate meal program at the Walnut Senior Center. Those residents who cannot leave their home continue to receive home delivered meals by the YWCA, while others are scheduled for drive-through (no contact) pick up.

# SENIOR DINE-IN NUTRITION LUNCH PROGRAM

As of June 20, 2022, Los Angeles County has reinstated the Senior Dine-In Nutrition Lunch program. The Dine-In program is open to older adults aged 60 years and older. Currently we are serving hot meals Monday through Wednesday on a first-come first-serve basis. To participant, guest must complete an intake form, check-in opens at 10:30 am with meals served from 11:00 am to 12:00 pm or until food is available.
