DISCUSSION/REVIEW

• Cafeteria Plan

This Study Session is intended to provide the City Council with an analysis of the current cafeteria plan offered to City Employees and provide recommendations on how to improve the benefit package beginning January 1, 2024. It is Staff's intent to inform Council of the medical rate increases, provide a comparative analysis of benefit packages being offered by other agencies, and discuss the proposal to revise the benefit package currently being offered to fulltime Staff. This recommendation will assist to accommodate the rate increases, and to close the gap between Walnut's cafeteria plan and various local municipalities.
