- 1. Appropriate \$100,000 from Park In-Lieu Fund Reserves (06) to the Walnut Ranch Park Pickleball Conversion and Tennis Court Renovation Project; and
- 2. Authorize staff to issue change orders in the amount of \$100,016 to Moore United Construction for additional scope needed to complete the project.

7. Approval to Purchase Reflective Street Signs from Safeway Sign Company
