#### **SUMMARY:**

Each year the Youth Advisory Commission develops a list of goals and projects for the upcoming school year.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

At the February 8, 2016 Youth Advisory Commission meeting, the Commission discussed appointing project leads to assist with the City of Walnut's annual Family Science Night event on March 29. The event will involve demonstrations and experiments. The three project leads will attend each planning meeting for the event and report back to the committee in order to complete assigned tasks from these planning meetings.

#### **STAFF ANALYSIS:**

Staff has discussed the topic that was suggested at the January 11, 2016 Youth Advisory Commission (YAC) meeting. Staff would like the Commission to consider the following topics:

- 1. Dividing up into three groups, each of which will assist in a separate experiment for Family Science Night.
- 2. Determining a separate experiment project for each group to show to the public during the event

3. Each group will be responsible to meet separately and work with Coordinator Watanabe and their project leader to ensure all tasks and décor is completed on time for the event.

Staff will guide the discussion of goals and projects and act in an advisory capacity. Please be prepared to do some brainstorming at the meeting.
